CARNIVAL - COSTUMES

Carnival costumes for Pre-CanSkate and CanSkate will be handed out on **Monday March 18th**. StarSkate costumes will be handed out starting **Tuesday March 19th**. **It is important that you pick up, check the size and try on your costume prior to Picture Day**. If your costume does not fit perfectly, please try to trade with someone in your number or hem and shorten the costume as needed. Only sewing that can easily be undone please. Please appreciate that we need to select costumes sight unseen and have done our best to accommodate your child's size with availability of sizing.

CARNIVAL – PICTURE DAY

Picture day will be held on **Monday, March 25th** for Pre & CanSkate in carnival. **Tuesday April 2nd** StarSkate & Adult. A group photo will be taken, and skaters have the option to take an individual photo for each number. **An envelope will be handed out prior to pictures with purchasing options. Photos will be done by Story Photography. Please bring filled out envelope with payment on picture day. Photos will be ready for pick-up at Carnival.**

CARNIVAL – WARM ROOM SEATING

Anyone needing/wanting seating upstairs in the arena (warm room) during the carnival shows should sign up on the sheets posted on the glass upstairs prior to **Thursday April 18th**. This reserved seating is available on a "first come-first served" basis and seating is limited.

CARNIVAL – DRESS REHEARSAL

Dress rehearsal will be on **Friday, April 19th** beginning at 5 p.m.

CARNIVAL – SHOWS

There are two carnival shows on **Saturday, April 20th** at 2:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. Please be here 45 minutes prior to each show. Both general admission tickets and parent passes (one price for both shows) are available for sale prior to carnival. Advanced tickets are only available during skating sessions from the executive or ask a coach and they will direct you to someone who can give you a hand. Tickets will be available upstairs by the skating room.

CARNIVAL – COSTUME RETURN

Carnival costumes need to remain in your dressing room after the evening show along with your carnival name tag.

CARNIVAL – ITEMS TO PURCHASE

Tickets will be available at the door for spectators as well as sold in advance. All skaters are free, including adults involved in the Skater/Guest number, those working at the shows and executive members. Parent passes need to be purchased in advance and will be for sale only until dress rehearsal – Friday April 19th.
