Thank you to everyone who ordered "SKATING FOLK" wear in our recent fundraiser. Orders are now ready for pick up in the skating room upstairs in the arena.

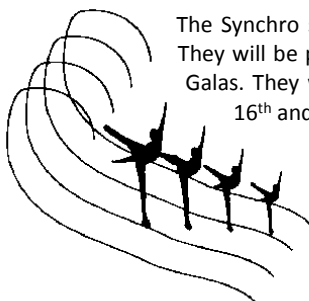
